The mean total score of the parents' perception scale (Table 5) was 56.93 out of 72 which represents a moderate perception. However, the perception was statistically significant with the age of the caregiver ?2(2) = 6.038, p = 0.049, in which the 40 Years and above group showed higher scores. Progress .children made with the treatment was statistically significant with perception ?2(2) = 13.015, p = 0.001
