

The Hierarchy of Controls is a safety system used to reduce or eliminate hazards at work.

- 4)Administrative Controls – Change work practices How it reduces risk: Reduces how long or how often workers are exposed. It ranks safety measures from most effective to least effective
- 1)Elimination – Remove the hazard completely How it reduces risk: No hazard = no exposure.
- 3)Engineering Controls – Physically isolate people from the hazard How it reduces risk: Workers can't come into contact with the .hazard even though it's still present
