

In the Hajj pilgrimage to Mecca in Islam, the pilgrims perform a set of rituals called the rites of Hajj, including the stoning of the Jamarat, and on the Day of Sacrifice, which is the first day of Eid al-Adha, pilgrims leave in abundance after the dawn prayer from Muzdalifah heading to Wadi Mina, about 6 km north of the Great Mosque of Mecca.<sup>694</sup> others, according to the official Saudi version
