

Snow leopards are predatory animals that belong to the Felidae family, which includes 36 species of snow leopards that are distributed throughout the high mountains of Central Asia. Snow leopards in the wild eat musk deer, badgers, and domestic livestock such as Sheep and goats. Snow leopards live in the Alpine and sub-Alpine regions. In the wild, snow leopards eat musk deer, badgers, and domestic livestock such as sheep and goats. They have a pale yellowish color with their dense gray-black coat.
