

The Grand Hall of the Grand Egyptian Museum boasts an impressive collection, including the colossal statue of Ramesses II, the Sakkara Cannon listing 58 kings from the first to the nineteenth dynasty, and the Victory Column of Merenpetah commemorating his ancient conquests. Also featured are the Ptolemaic King and Queen statues from the sunken city of Heraklion and ten statues of Senusret I symbolizing Egypt's unification and enduring legacy
