Some people, when they come into contact with airborne, animals and plants, will experience allergic—" reactions. –Why do these reactions happen? When a person is exposed to allergens produced by animals or plants, their body produces antihistamine or histamine compounds through the activation of antigen–antibody reactions. This results in allergic symptoms such as fever, asthma, and dermatitis. – nowadays specific tests are used to trigger allergic reactions for diagnostic purposes
