

In Algeria, the responsibility for providing hotel ratings lies with the Ministry of Tourism, Handicrafts, and Family Work (Ministere du Tourisme, de l'Artisanat et du Travail Familial). Monitoring Compliance: Periodic re-evaluations are conducted to ensure hotels maintain their standards. Conducting Inspections: Specialized inspectors or teams authorized by the Ministry evaluate hotels to ensure compliance with the required standards. Promoting Quality: The Ministry supports initiatives to improve service quality and encourages hotels to upgrade their facilities to attract more tourists.
