It's expected several teams, players, and fans to protest against Qatar's human rights record during the tournament, prompting FIFA to write to all 32 national teams competing at the World Cup telling them to "now focus on the football". There's never been a right time to talk about human rights issues in Qatar as far as they [FIFA] are concerned. Now is the time to apply pressure on these issues (newsround, 2022).

Within the preparations and even in the early beginning of World Cup 2022 hosted by Qatar multiple complaints have been held against the strict rules that were imposed. Soon due to the great organization and the decent reception this came to an end. Qatar has managed to create a unique experience and an .unforgettable World Cup showing real value and meaning
