

AIDS is the advanced stage of HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus) infection. Regular Monitoring:

Ongoing assessment of CD4 counts and overall health to adjust treatment as needed. Symptoms

Symptoms of AIDS can vary, but common signs include: Rapid weight loss Recurring fever or profuse night sweats Extreme fatigue Prolonged swelling of the lymph nodes Diarrhea that lasts for more than a week Pneumonia Skin rashes or sores Opportunistic infections: Infections that occur more frequently .and are more severe in individuals with weakened immune systems
