

Christie Sides Delivers Blunt Message To Caitlin Clark, Fever Critics. Caitlin Clark and the Indiana Fever have had a challenging beginning to their 2024 WNBA season. However, she has been struggling with turnovers, averaging 5.8 per game as she adapts to the fast-paced nature of the WNBA. Clark and her teammates have been criticized heavily by WNBA fans for their ugly start to the season.
