

Former Iowa Stars Kate Martin, Gabbie Marshall React To Caitlin Clark's Golf Post. Amid the WNBA offseason, Indiana Fever guard Caitlin Clark tried out her luck on the golf course. Similar to what she did for the WNBA, Clark brought in a substantial amount of ticket sales for the event, reportedly 12 times as much as in previous years. Notably, Clark was paired with two LPGA greats during the 18-hole course, including world No. 1 Nelly Korda in the early portion of the pro-am and, in the latter half, Hall of Famer Annika Sorenstam, whom the event was named after. Clark highlighted her latest golfing experience with an Instagram post on Thursday evening. The trio led their school to two straight NCAAW national championship appearances in their final two seasons but fell just short of the title in both. Both Clark and Martin went on to be selected in the 2024 WNBA draft: Clark went No. 1 overall to the Fever, and Martin was the Aces' second-round selection. On Wednesday morning, the former Iowa Hawkeyes star participated in The ANNIKA driven by Gainbridge pro-am tournament in Belleair, Florida.
