Nursing History o Collect data about erectile dysfunction in a male who has diabetes and may be-1 indicated in the review of the cardiovascular, neurologic and genitourinary system. Nursing history data indicating the need for a physical examination include the following: 1– Suspicion of infertility, pregnancy or STDs 2– Reports of discharge, presence of lump or change in color, size and shape of a genital organ.o Disfiguring conditions such as burns, skin conditions, birth marks, scars, and ostomies Specific medication therapy that decreases sexual drive or causes erectile or ejaculatory dysfunction.3– Identifying clients at risk o Physical, psychosocial, or sexual abuse Altered body structure or function due .to trauma, pregnancy, recent child birth, anatomic abnormalities of the genitals, or disease
