

When the A320 was created, it was the first narrow-body Aeroplane to incorporate a considerable number of composite materials. This aircraft outperforms both the Boeing 737 and the Boeing 717, as measured by their respective external cabin diameters: 3.95 metres (12 feet 11.5 inches) for the Boeing 737 and 3.34 metres (10 feet 10 inches) for the Boeing 717.
