However, the rookie made headlines not for her performance on the court but because she was the subject of a hard foul by Chennedy Carter in the last seconds of the third quarter. The impact of Carter's foul left Clark on the floor, with the referee deeming it a common foul rather than a flagrant transition from the NCAA to the WNBA has been a bit more challenging than expected, as her season with the Indiana Fever began with a poor 2–8 record, with their second win of the season coming this Saturday against the Chicago Sky by a narrow score of 71–70.
