said to be geat, they alsoguarded against eelings of self-satisfaction. Opel concluded: "If any of us in our company behave in any way that reinforces the idea of smugness of power or arrogance, then our image could be severely tarnished. The hero of today can become the bum of tomorrow." But during those same years, IBM failed to see the growing commoditi- zation of its main business lines-mainframe computer systems and minicomputers. Opels successor, John Akers, was replaced.
