Industry in Algeria is one of the pillars on which the Algerian economy is based, especially the hydrocarbons industry belonging to the mining industry sector, and despite the diversity of the productivity of this sector, it is modest in terms of yield, and the produced hydrocarbons accounted for about 2.9% of the production of natural gas in the whole world, And about 2.2 of the total global crude oil production during 2006, and Algeria produced in 2006 about 38,914 tons of gold. This initiative also aims at promoting the digital economy, development and setting up new flexible and innovative mechanisms for financing projects and encouraging industrialists to modernize their production equipment.
