

The mean total score of the parents' perception scale (Table 5) was 56.93 out of 72 which represents a moderate perception. However, the perception was statistically significant with the age of the caregiver  $\chi^2(2) = 6.038$ ,  $p = 0.049$ , in which the 40 Years and above group showed higher scores. Progress children made with the treatment was statistically significant with perception  $\chi^2(2) = 13.015$ ,  $p = 0.001$ .
