

Aside from these distinguishing garments, the Bhutanese guy may be seen wearing a variety of colored 'Kabneys,' also known as scarves. The highest judicial authority, the judge, is represented by a green kabney, whilst the district administrator is represented by a crimson scarf with white stripes. Every Bhutanese is required to follow this etiquette while interacting with higher-ranking officials or attending major national events. Such kabney delineation about the status of the men's authoritative power is seen as an act of acknowledgment. Bhutan's royal majesty wears a yellow scarf.
