

A young boy, lost from his Indian jungle village, is found by Father and Mother Wolf in their cave. Though the animals are surprised by the human child, Mother Wolf protects him as her own. Shere Khan, the tiger, demands the child, arguing humans don't belong in the wild, but Mother Wolf bravely refuses.
