

Caitlin Clark is the big absentee from Paris 2024: Shocking stat shows how bad the Team USA needs her. Team USA is marching steadily towards winning the gold medal in women's basketball at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games. Internet sleuths noticed this statistic and immediately criticized Clark's absence.
