Business Requirements Document (BRD) is a formal document that outlines the business requirements for a project or system, providing a clear understanding of what needs to be achieved from a business perspective. Purpose of a BRD: o Clarity and Alignment: It ensures all stakeholders, including business owners, project managers, and technical teams, are aligned on project objectives. The BRD ensures all stakeholders have a shared understanding of the goals and expectations, helping to prevent scope creep and misalignment later in the project. Key Components of a BRD: o Executive Summary: A high–level overview of the project, its goals, and its alignment with business objectives o Business Process Diagrams: Visual representations of existing business processes and workflows that the project will impact or improve o Stakeholder List: Identifies all individuals, teams, or organizations involved in or impacted by the project o Non–Functional Requirements: Describes performance, security, and other quality attributes that the system must meet, such as scalability or usability.
