German club Leipzig announced the signing of striker Timo Werner from Chelsea on a 4-year contract until 2026. Timo played with Chelsea for two seasons, where he participated in 89 matches, in which he scored 23 goals and provided 21 assists to his teammates. The German young man's journey with Chelsea was not successful at all, as Werner tried to adapt to the style of the English Premier League and adapt to the way the Blues play, but to no avail. Despite the arrival of German coach Thomas Tuchel to take charge of the team and his intensive attempts to use Werner, he did not succeed either. For his part, Werner published a statement on social media saying goodbye to Chelsea fans and everyone working in the Blues system, and explained his aspiration to play at Stamford Bridge again in the future. Where Werner will return to his former team after his journey in the English stadiums with about 20 million euros, to complete his previous success with Leipzig. The transfer of the 26-year-old to Chelsea in the past cost the Blues' coffers 53 million euros after the strong competition with Liverpool.
