

a- –A postmortem oral examination should be performed by one person, while another observes and confirms the findings, and a third records the findings on correct dental charts. Following this, the pathology division usually resects jaws from inaccessible remains to allow for analysis and radiographic inspection. The team will then input this data into a computer program to collate and cross reference information.

b- The human dental remains will be photographed after they arrive at the morgue's dental location.
