

In the VI–V centuries. Mandatory guidelines when choosing a place for the construction of temples in ancient Greece were the mineral spring (the water of which, as you know, has a healing effect) and cypress grove (the air of which is also healing). The servants of Asklepeion strictly followed the cleanliness of the sanctuary and its visitors. The most magnificent was the sanctuary of Asclepius in Epidauros, on whose territory the temple of Asclepius (central building), the temples of Hygiea, Aphrodite, Themis and Apollo, as well as a bath, library, gymnasium, a sports stadium and the largest theater in Greece were located.
