The findings suggest that while the vaccine is generally well-tolerated and safe, there is a need for increased awareness about the importance of completing the full vaccination course. Additionally, some participants expressed hesitancy due to misconceptions or lack of information, indicating the importance of educational campaigns. By addressing these concerns and promoting the benefits of vaccination, public health initiatives can enhance vaccine uptake and reduce the incidence of hepatitis B among high-risk groups. Continued monitoring and public health education are crucial to improving compliance and achieving broader immunization coverage.
