War had changed Japanese in various sectors which's had positive impact on their economy till these days. The cultural impact of the war on Japanese population was far more profound as compared to Germans, before war Japanese were steeped in traditions and were not willing to adapt, but after the war, due to increased presence of American forces, younger generation of Japanese were far more receptive towards American culture and traditions and as a result, American culture became very popular in Japan which helped in the development of progressive and knowledgeable society (Campbell, 2016). Furthermore, Japanese had strict work ethics which resulted in development of quality principles after the WW2 which helped them to gain competitive advantage over their worldwide competition. For instance, Crafts like sorting cultured pearls for woman, New cultural dance like: Hula–Hoop and Movie studio filming of the war. As a result, the Japanese economy improved rapidly and by 1971 it became one of the first developed countries in the south east Asia. During the WW2, Japanese developed various encryption devices which were based on Enigma machine, the concept of which were later used in the development of computers and chips. The Japanese focused on technological advancements and high technology industries (Japan–Guide, 2020). The rise in Japanese industry was based upon its focus on technological innovation and research (Hane, 1996).
