The referees reviewed the incident extensively, ultimately deciding to uphold the initial foul on Zandalasini and issue a technical foul to Clark. Her frustrations culminated in a physical altercation when Lynx forward Cecilia Zandalasini fouled her while she was bringing the ball up the court. Indiana, typically known for their offensive capabilities, relied on their defense to stay competitive in this matchup. Entering the game with an impressive streak of performances, Clark had consistently delivered double–figure assists in her last five outings, making her a critical offensive engine for the Fever. This reaction from Clark was indicative of her mounting frustration, compounded by six turnovers, some of which were due to her own careless passes. Despite Clark's and her teammates' offensive struggles, the Fever managed to keep the game close, showcasing a strong defensive effort.
