Sheikh Sulaiman bin Abdul–Aziz Al–Rajh, the world–renowned philanthropist and winner of the 2012 King Faisal International Prize for Service to lam, has not always been a billionaire Born in 1920, he spent his youth in Al–Qassim where he and his brother Saleh began their business, changing money for pilgrims, on their way to the cities of Makkah and Madinah Their business expanded in the 1970s during the all boom in Saudi Arabia. The foundation organites and oversees a substantial number of charities and humanitarians activities worldwide In May 2011, Solaiman Al–Rahs announced that he was donating most of his \$77 bilion fortune to charty During his Mesme A–Rajhi distributed the rest of his wealth to his children in order to avoid poternal disputes over inheritance that could destroy kinship and harmony among them.
