2.1 Definition of "Wallpaper" Noun: Paper that is pasted in vertical strips over the walls of a room to provide a decorative surface. (1) In interior design: Wallpaper is a nonwoven (paper) or woven (fabric) backing, decoratively printed for application to walls of a residence or business. Wallpaper is not considered essential to the decoration of a structure; however, it has become a primary method by which to impart style, atmosphere, or color into a room. (2)

2.2 History of "Wallpaper" The earliest wallpapers used in Europe as early as the thirteenth century were painted with images of popular religious icons. This technique is used to add tactile details to the surface
