

Intact Carrots Bruising, Shatter–Cracks, and Tip–Breakage: Description: These damages are often caused by rough handling during harvesting, packaging, or transportation. White Root: Description: A physiological disorder where carrots develop patches or streaks of low color due to less–than–ideal growing conditions, such as nutrient deficiencies. Sprouting: Description: Carrots can sprout new shoots if stored under conditions that are too warm or not adequately controlled. Mitigation: Store carrots at low temperatures to inhibit sprouting and preserve quality.
