

3.o Recommendation: Country X should engage with Country Y and other parties to renegotiate terms or address its concerns within the treaty framework, demonstrating good faith in resolving the dispute. Country X's unilateral withdrawal citing economic burden could be viewed as an act of bad faith, especially if it has not engaged in meaningful dialogue or negotiation with other treaty parties.

Conclusion o Country X's Withdrawal: Without a specific withdrawal clause or justification under the VCLT (e.g., fundamental change in circumstances), Country X's unilateral withdrawal would likely be deemed a violation of international law.

Pacta Sunt Servanda: o This principle obliges states to honor their commitments under international treaties.
