

Fever coach Christie Sides gives a lesson to Caitlin Clark due to on-court behaviour and disciplinary issues. During the Fever's most recent loss – 88–82 at home to the Los Angeles Sparks – Clark found herself in trouble for getting a little too mouthy with the referee, leading to her being whistled. Boston pleaded her case after being called, while Clark raised her arms in disbelief when she was called up for going over an opposing screen.
