

Angel Reese's Chicago Sky debut sends X wild with crazy streaming numbers. Lynx head coach Cheryl Reeve suggested that fans should have compensated the impromptu broadcaster, emphasizing the rapid growth and changing dynamics in the league, "Anybody that watched it should send three bucks to the person," Reeve stated. Sky coach Teresa Weatherspoon reflected on the situation as a learning opportunity, emphasizing leadership and confidence within the team: "This is a learning process for all of us. And we're going through that process in the right way. On a Friday night preseason opener against the Minnesota Lynx, fans were disappointed to find that the WNBA's streaming app failed to broadcast the game, contradicting its initial promise to stream all preseason games. Reese and Kamilla Cardoso's debut in the WNBA for the Chicago Sky garnered significant attention and impressive viewership figures, despite a broadcasting hiccup from the league. The fan, @heyheyitsalli, queried her followers on Twitter, now known as X, "Would y'all want me to try and stream the game on here?? No promises on the quality but I can try."
