Caitlin Clark decides on huge Unrivaled offer as WNBA star's priorities become clear. Basketball star Caitlin Clark has reportedly rejected an offer to join the new Unrivaled 3v3 basketball league, despite the organisation leaving room for the Indiana Fever guard to change her mind. The 22-year-old broke the NCAA scoring record during her time in college with the lowa Hawkeyes and was the first draft pick when she joined the Indiana Fever, helping the team reach the playoffs for the first time in eight years. There was renewed hope that Clark would accept an offer from Unrivaled when the league was expanded from 30 to 36 players, but the latest reports suggest that she has different plans for the offseason. It has been reported by ESPN that Clark is set to turn down an offer from Unrivaled amid previous claims that the league were willing to pay \$1 million to get the Indiana Fever star onboard. It's believed one has been earmarked for Clark should she opt in, having been one of the main reasons behind the WNBA's boom in popularity this year.
