Symptoms: Symptoms of AIDS can vary, but common signs include: Rapid weight loss, Recurring fever or profuse night sweats, Extreme fatigue, Prolonged swelling of the lymph nodes, Diarrhea that lasts for more than a week, Pneumonia, Skin rashes or sores. Opportunistic infections: Infections that occur more frequently and are more severe in individuals with weakened immune systems.
