Method A: The salinity can be measured by titration in the laboratory using a silver nitrate solution. Calculate the salinity of the freshwater sample using the formula: Salinity (PSU)= [CI] \times 1.805 +0.03 the titrating solution of silver nitrate (AgNO3) is made in such a way that 2 ml of it corresponds to 1 g of CI per kg of water. The indicator solution will turn the sample yellow.
