

The research required a theoretical study of what was stated in previous research and studies. Preparing a measure of academic ambition for linguistically weak learners in the primary stage. After completing the experiment, statistical processing of the scores of the pre- and post-applications was carried out, and a number of results were reached, the most important of which are: – There are statistically significant differences at the level (0.01) between the average scores of the research group members in both the test and the observation card, in favor of the post-test.
