

tourism supply Definition and Characteristics IN GENERAL, tourism supply includes all that the tourist destination has to offer to its actual and potential tourists. (2) Land configuration and landscape plains scenic mountains, lakes, rivers, beaches, unusual formations, panoramic views, waterfalls, volcanic zones, grottos, etc (3) The Sylvan element: large forests, rare trees, etc (C) As tourism is not yet a basic need of man, tourism supply is subject to competition from other goods and services supplies The law of substitution is active in this regard Tourism Supply Components Tourism supply can be natural or man-made: Natural amenities (1) Climate, mild, sunny, dry, clean air.
