In both rural and urban settings, distinct advantages and disadvantages shape the lifestyle of residents. Striking a balance between the advantages of both lifestyles could be a viable solution, allowing individuals to enjoy the benefits of rural serenity and urban opportunities. Nevertheless, the fast–paced lifestyle, high living costs, and potential isolation due to the sheer size of the population can pose challenges. Some may find solace and fulfillment in the tranquility of rural life, while others may thrive in the dynamic environment of urban settings. On the other hand, urban life offers diverse opportunities, abundant services, and a vibrant cultural scene. However, limited access to essential services and economic constraints can hinder the overall well–being of residents.
