

CRP is a pentameric protein synthesized by the liver, whose level rises in response to inflammation. When latex particles coated with human anti-CRP are mixed with a patient's serum containing C-reactive proteins, this results in visible agglutination within 2 minutes. This is a slide agglutination test for the qualitative and semiquantitative detection of C-Reactive Protein (CRP) in human serum. CRP Test is based on the latex agglutination method.
